Our congratulations this week go to all the students who performed at the Voice of Youth cluster final. Tatiana from Year 6 came third in the competition with an inspiring speech about Christian Persecution. Our Year 5 children are also currently participating in a debating competition that has been hosted by Delany College. We have progressed through to the semi-finals that will be held on Thursday.

A number of parents have indicated recently that they may not have received notes from school. Our teachers do take every care in asking children to put notes in their bags to take home. We now have some significant work scheduled for the next school holidays. The area behind our Kindergarten room will be enclosed to make a more comfortable space for the children and teachers to use. Our thanks go to the Catholic Education Office for supporting these changes and we hope that our walkathon will raise enough funds to complete the project.

Our thanks also to the P&F who recently purchased "Connect 4" games for the main playground and sand boxes for Kindy. This will be the first stage in having games and other activities for the children at recess and lunch times.


