PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE:





Dear Parents, Students and Teachers,

I am very pleased to back at school after a wonderful trip to the Holy Land and Rome. The experience of pilgrimage is a life-changing one. To walk in the footsteps of Jesus is very tangible way of understanding the message of the Gospel and I feel very privileged to have been part of this experience with 20 other Principals in our Diocese. The world is full of extremes but the conflict that exists in Israel and Palestine is in complete contrast to the message of hope and love and peace that was so characteristic of Jesus and the Apostles in the early Christian communities. I was also privileged to be part of the huge crowd in St Peter's Square the day after the tragedy in Paris, to pray the Angelus with Pope Francis and listen to his message of peace for the world. Over the next few weeks I am hoping to be able to share some of my experiences with the children to attempt to help them understand their faith a deeper level.

I would like to take this opportunity of thanking Mrs Garzaniti and Mr Knight for taking on the leadership of the school in my absence. They are both outstanding leaders as are all members of our leadership team. We are very fortunate to have this calibre of leadership in our school.

The staff are busily working on our end of year reports and these will be sent home on Thursday 3rd December. This is a great opportunity to check on your child's progress and acknowledge areas of success and growth. Please remember that a grade of 'C' means that a child is working at an appropriate stage level. More information regarding grades will be included with the report. Please take the time to read this carefully.

As we approach the end of the year I believe it is important to emphasise some of the expectations that we have that make our school safe and help to maintain a high level of organisation. Those parents who use Kiss and Ride, please remember to be patient and display your child's name in the front window of your car. Be very aware of the children's safety and other drivers. If you entering or leaving the school at dismissal time please use the gate near year 5, not the main gate. Children will be dismissed from Area B, not from the Year 5 classrooms. Haircuts with lines and other designs are not appropriate and running shoes need to be predominantly white. Both of these are proper school uniform expectations that will be maintained. Absenteeism remains a significant factor in children's progress. Please talk to the class teacher if you child is away for any unusual length of time and provide a letter for the absence. If you are not returning to school next year, could you please contact the office as soon as possible.

Some preliminary planning for 2016 includes the first week of school. The staff will meet together on Wednesday 27th January from 8.00am to 12.00pm. We will then be conducting our MAI (Mathematical Assessment Interview) on that day and continuing on Thursday 28th January. School will start for all classes except Kindergarten on Friday 29th January and this will give the teachers an opportunity to meet their children and set some expectations for the year before we begin our first full week of learning on Monday 1st February (kinder will start on this date). More information will be sent home soon, confirming these dates and the details for online booking.

We fit shoes and allow for growth, but are happy to exchange if there is a growth spurt after the holidays.

IMPORTANT CHANGES TO TRAVEL PASSES- OPAL CARD

The School Opal card has officially launch its new online application for students travelling in the Opal public transport region.

The application can be found at *transportnsw.info/school-students*

The School Opal card gives eligible students free travel to and from school on school days. The School Opal card makes travel simpler, because now students don't need multiple application forms and passes if they use different transport operators within the Opal network.

Students with school travel passes this year will not need to apply for a School Opal card unless they are changing schools, campus, their home address or moving from year 2 to 3 or year 6 to 7.

Those students who do not need to apply will have a School Opal card sent to the school for the beginning of the first term in 2016.
