Dear Students, Parents and Teachers,

I am very pleased to announce that our **soft fall** area is going ahead. Work will begin in the September holidays. We have been very fortunate in obtaining a **\$30,000** grant from **Wentworthville Leagues Club** and **Mr David Bourne**, **Principal of St. Paul's College**, has also generously donated **\$25,000** towards the project. I believe that the soft fall area will allow the children to have a space where they can play safely as well as having a place for outdoor learning. I would like to acknowledge the efforts of **Mr Kieron Maye** (parent) who organised the grant application and the tender process for the companies providing the work. **Mr Robert Simonetto** (parent) also provided much needed building consultation on the whole process. We are very fortunate in deed to have people of this caliber to organise large projects such as this one. Together with the P&F we are now looking at re-surfacing other areas of the playground in the future.

Our **Staff Development Day** last week was an excellent opportunity for our teachers to unpack the new **Mathematics** and **English Syllabus** documents. It was a very productive day and has allowed us to begin planning for 2015.




