Dear Parents, Students and Teachers

Congratulations to our Year 3 and Year 5 students who completed their NAPLAN assessments last week. There was a great sense of confidence in their ability as they prepared for the task.

Thank you to all the parents who last week attended the first P&F Parent Information session for this year, *Keeping Kids Safe*. It was a very interesting and informative night with Nicole Hunt from Holroyd Council and Merrylands Police. Some key points from the night included:

- -Ensuring Kiss and Ride rules and regulations are continued to be followed by all parents in order for Holroyd Council to allow the school to continue to use. Council will inform the school at the end of Term 2 if Kiss and Ride will continue.
- Ensuring an adult is holding a child's hand when crossing a road, walking on the footpath or when in a carpark.
- -Ensuring your child is aware of pick up procedures, whether it be kiss and ride, parent pick up etc to avoid any unnecessary stress.
- -Ensuring seat belts are worn at all times.
- -Showing patience and care towards each other to ensure we all arrive home safely.

Our Kiss and Ride process is operating more smoothly as cars are now moving more quickly through the circuit. Please ensure that the child's name is clearly displayed on your <u>dash board and it remains</u> there until he/she is picked up. This gives the duty teacher a chance to call the name if your child has not responded. Please make sure that you move right up to the end of the circuit so more cars can enter.

Save the date for the next Parent Information Session on Tuesday 7th June on Literacy presented by our Assistant Principal, Mrs Frances Garzaniti. This session will provide invaluable information and knowledge that will enable you to assist your child.

It has become noticeable in the mornings that a lot of children are gathering outside the gate on Braeside Road. Some are arriving as early as 7.45am. These children are unsupervised as the gate does not open until 8.15am and supervision does not start until 8.30am. The mornings are getting colder and the children should not be standing on the footpath outside the school. Please make sure that you child/ren arrive between 8.30 and 9.00am.

Earlier this week I sent out a message saying that while the weather remains unseasonably warm it is acceptable for the children to continue wearing their summer uniform. It is important however that they wear either summer or winter and not a mixture of both. As the temperature changes over the course of the term, we should all be in our winter uniforms very soon.

Attached to the newsletter is some information on Volunteers working in the school. New legislation requires volunteers to register using the *Working With Children Check*. We have been waiting for some time for this process to begin so that we can encourage volunteers to work in the classroom. I will be sending out a letter this week asking parents who may be interested in working in the classrooms, to attend a workshop to discuss how you can support reading and other subjects in the classroom.

BUILDING CHILD SAFE COMMUNITIES – NEW FORMS FOR ALL VOLUNTEERS AND CONTRACTORS

Building Child Safe Communities' is a new initiative developed by Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta that enhances our commitment to ensuring the safety and wellbeing of all students in our care. It is now a requirement that all volunteers and contractors complete an online undertaking form that confirms expectations in relation to behaviour whilst volunteering or contracting at schools, Catholic Out of Schools Hours Care and Catholic Early Learning Centres. This undertaking form also seeks to determine the suitability of volunteers and contractors by requiring them to declare that they do not have a criminal history involving children.

Volunteers – please click on 'Building Child Safe Communities – Undertaking for Volunteers' or access the form via the Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta public webpage http://www.parra.catholic.edu.au, then click on 'Child Protection Training Forms' (halfway down page on the right hand side).



Then click on 'Volunteer Form' (halfway down page).

You will receive a confirmation email once the form has been submitted. Your details are maintained confidentially in a central database and a copy of your confirmation is emailed to the location where you are volunteering.

Contractors – please click on '<u>Building Child Safe Communities</u> – <u>Undertaking for Contractors</u> or access the form via the Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta public webpage http://www.parra.catholic.edu.au, then click on 'Child Protection Training Forms' (halfway down page on the right hand side).



Then click on 'Contractor Form' (bottom of page).

You will receive a confirmation email once the form has been submitted. Your details are maintained confidentially in a central database and a copy of your confirmation is emailed to the location where you are contracting.

A new form is required:

- For each location that you are a volunteer or contractor
- If any of the details you have provided on the form change

Applications received after this date may not be successful.











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


