School student transport pass applications for 2019 opened on Monday, 15 October 2018.

Students progressing to year 3 and year 7 **do not** need to re-apply **if** they:

- · are continuing at the same school
- · are residing at the same address
- · have not been sent an expiry notification from Transport for NSW.

Where a student meets the new distance eligibility, the system will automatically update their entitlement. If they do not meet the new eligibility, they will receive an expiry notification. Term Bus Pass holders will receive a notification to re-apply. If students need to update their information or re-apply, they should go online to:
